Members discussed year to date spend.

4. Discussion of draft Budget in relation to Precept Request to Bridgend County Borough Council for 2022-23

Clerk had previously provided members with draft budget for 2022-23 and recommendations relating to consideration of Precept Request.

Members discussed the difficulties of accurately considering the precept requirement for the forthcoming year, in the absence of final confirmation from BCBC that the joint project to provide 2 x Puffin Crossings at Bridge Street and Pigsaw Street. It was agreed the 90K budgeted for this project should be carried over to the year 2022-23 to allow this council to fund 1 x Puffin Crossing even if BCBC do not go forward with the partnership previously agreed.

Cllr Amy Jones proposed the precept request for 2022-23 remain unchanged from the 2021-22 precept and remain at 120K. Cllr Radmore seconded this proposal. All members were in agreement.
